Ingredients

Wheat Middlings, Ground Corn, Ground Soybean Hulls, Ground Oats, Dehydrated Alfalfa Meal, Cane Molasses, Calcium Carbonate, Salt, Ammonium Chloride, Zinc Sulfate, Vitamin E Supplement, Choline Chloride, Preserved with Mixed Tocopherols, Cholecalciferol (Vitamin D3), Calcium Pantothenate, Vitamin A Acetate, Citric Acid (a Preservative), Thiamine Mononitrate, Nicotinic Acid, Riboflavin-5-Phosphate, Manganese Sulfate, Vitamin B12 Supplement, Zinc Oxide, Manganous Oxide, Ferrous Sulfate, Potassium Iodide, Sodium Molybdate, Rosemary Extract, Cobalt Carbonate, Sodium Selenite, Biotin.

Feeding Directions

- Provide as supplemental treat to barnyard and petting zoo animals.
- Do not feed free-choice or as sole diet.
- Always provide plenty of fresh, clean water.
- Thoroughly wash feed and water bowls on a regular basis. It is always good practice to wash hands thoroughly after feeding and/or handling animals.
- This diet is not for human consumption.

Storage Conditions

For best results, reseal the bag between uses or store contents of open paper sack in container with sealing lid. Store in a cool (75°F/24°C or colder), dry (approximately 50% RH) location free from rodents and insects. Do not offer moldy or insect-infested feed to animals as it may result in illness, performance loss or death. Freezing will not harm the diet and may extend freshness. Use within 1 year of bag manufacturing or "Best if Used By" date.
